What is iFrame?

An iFrame is a HTML document embedded inside another HTML document on a website. The iFrame HTML element is used to insert content from the Allworx website into your Web page.

Content Implementation Instructions

The iFrame tag is simple to implement in your web pages. The content is hosted on Allworx.com and automatically updates on your web page when Allworx makes changes to the site.

1. The iFrame has a width of 582 pixels and a height of 840 pixels.
 - a. If your site body section is static, your site must have at least this width and height to display accurately.
 - b. If your site is dynamically sized, (adjusts page height based off of content), then no changes to your height settings within the web page will need to be made.
2. Place the iFrame tags below at the location on your site where you would like the Allworx iFrame to be viewed. Highlight all the code below and copy and paste it into your content area using a web publisher tool (Dreamweaver, Contribute, Front Page, etc). It is recommended that all code below is pasted in its entirety. Any changes to the code may cause the iFrame to be viewed improperly. Be sure your scrolling setting is marked as "yes" to allow visibility of the complete pages.

Here is the iFrame code to be placed within your body content area:

Netscape 4.x and some older Internet Explorer browsers do not recognize iFrame tags. When those browsers encounter an iFrame, the tag is ignored, and an error message will be displayed.
